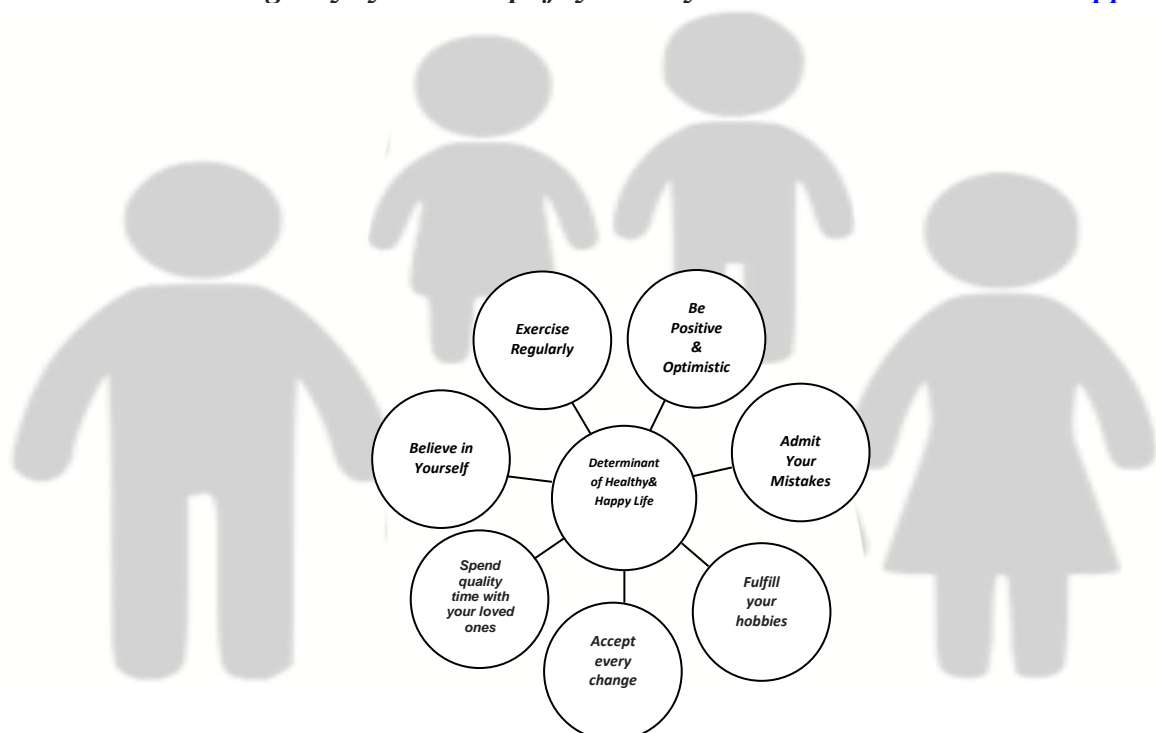



- Students will not be allowed to leave in between the School hours. Parents are requested not to send their wards to School when the child is sick.
